Why do we offer "system benefits" programs?



- Save energy and demand
- Acquire "resources" avoid power production and infrastructure
- Maintain acquired savings ensure persistance of savings

The three legged stool of market transformation

- Market Transformation happens when:
 - Unfamiliar technology finds acceptance in the marketplace
 - In some cases, volume drives down costs; may drive up investment in R&D
 - Building codes and federal/state standards change.



"The facts" - how SBC programs help transform the market

- Helps offset the cost of technologies that save energy
- Provides another channel for emerging technologies, like solid state lighting
- Provides another view towards understanding market barriers that need to be addressed
- Includes the education component
 helps end users and specifiers
 understand the technology
- Contributes to the volumes in the market needed to sustain a technology



SSL Test Standards – Why this is important to SBC programs?

Its all about sustaining the savings and gaining acceptance in the marketplace

- Ensuring that technology, in this case solid state lighting, will last.
- End users and specifiers have a basis to compare SSL products and data to adequately design spaces.
- Helps manufacturers set baselines for technology, targets for performance and gauge the impact of future improvements to products



How do national initiatives help SBC programs

- An SBC program administrator covers a regional geography
- Requirements and product listing adopted across a broader footprint fosters more uniform expectations and messaging
- A national focus provides SBC program administrators with an exchange that helps the knowledge base for technology, issues and solutions
- Through a national forum, SBC administrators can provide some objective feedback to the marketplace and receive some in return
